Application deadline: June 16, 2014 (postmarked). Late applications will not be accepted.

Participation fee: 45,000 yen (40,000 yen for graduate students). The fee includes accommodation in shared rooms (2 to 3 persons) and all meals.

Call for papers:

- Proposals invited on content-based language instruction, immersion, bilingual education, or related theme. Commercial presentations will not be accepted.
- Presenters must be JACET members in good standing.
- 30 minute presentation in English (presentation time may be adjusted depending on the total number of accepted proposals).
- Intention to make a presentation should be indicated on the Application Form. Proposals should not exceed 2 A4 size pages (Times New Roman pt. 12; 40 lines per page). They should be completed in MS Word and include a title and a 1-paragraph abstract. Proposals should be sent as attachments to jacet@zb3.so-net.ne.jp. Message title should read: "Summer Seminar Presentation Proposal (First name, Last name).
- All received proposals will be reviewed by the organizing committee.
- All presenters will be requested to submit a 6-page summary of the presentation for inclusion in the Summer Seminar proceedings.

Participant application procedures:

- 1) By registered cash envelope (現金書留: Genkinkakitome): Include payment together with the completed Application Form
