

University Job Opening—Visiting Lecturer

Kyushu University, a national university corporation, is seeking a qualified native English speaker for the position of visiting lecturer in teaching English as a Foreign Language (EFL), beginning October 1st 2008. The ideal candidate should possess a Ph.D. degree in either TEFL / TESOL, English Language and Literature, American Literature, Communication / Speech studies, Cultural studies or related areas with several years of teaching experience. However, candidates possessing only an M.A. degree but with a strong teaching background will also be considered.

Responsibilities: Teach eight weekly English classes (90 minutes each) per semester to primarily first- and second-year students, maintain office hours, provide editorial assistance and assist with departmental matters.

Salary: Commensurate with qualifications, age and experience

Contract: The contract of employment begins on October 1st 2008 for an initial six-month term, and is renewable on April 1st 2009 and on April 1st 2010 for a maximum two-year term of employment ending on September 30th 2010.

All applicants are requested to send (1) a full curriculum vitae, (2) a list of publications, (3) copies of up to three publications, (4) a cassette tape(or CD)-recorded self introduction, and (5) two letters of reference (written within the past one year).
