We are looking for an instructor to teach 5 undergraduate courses including Advanced Essay Writing, English for International Communication, Presentations in English, and a seminar course. Furthermore, the successful candidate may be asked to teach additional subjects in the Graduate School such as Writing for Academic Purposes, English Education, etc.
6. Other required works:

Help with special activities and events, such as entrance examinations, placement tests, Freshman Camp, and Open Campus.
7. Number of classes to take charge of

Five classes for undergraduates (Advanced Essay Writing, English for International Communication, Presentations in English, seminar, etc.)

Possibly a few classes for graduate students.
8. Terms of the contract
 - (a) One-year contract. It is possible to extend the contract by a maximum of five years if the conditions prescribed by the University Regulations are met.
 - (b) 5,520, 000yen/year (professor)
5,280,000yen/year (associate professor)
5,040,000yen/year (lecturer)
 - (c) Research funds (400,000 yen/year). Eligible for additional funds in accordance with the University Regulations
 - (d) Family allowance; housing allowance; commuting allowance
 - (e) Overtime allowance(when the number of your classes is over five per week)
