

Position Opening:

The Faculty of Global and Media Studies, University of Nagasaki invites applications for the position of Special Lecturer of English.

1. Position: English instructor (non-tenured)
2. Number of Positions: One
3. Affiliation: Department of Global and Media Studies, Faculty of Global and Media Studies
4. Areas of Specialization: TESOL or related fields
5. Subjects to be taught:
English classes such as “Oral Communication”, “Writing”, “Debate”, “Speaking”, etc.
6. Required Qualifications:
 - 1) Native speaker of English, regardless of nationality
 - 2) MA or above in TESOL or related fields
 - 3) Sufficient communication abilities in Japanese
7. Major Duties:
 - 1) Teaching approximately nine 90-minute classes per week
 - 2) Consultation with students in the office
 - 3) Production of teaching materials, English proofreading, etc.
 - 4) Other duties assigned by the university and the faculty
8. Date of Employment: April 1, 2016
9. Employment Period: April 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017
(Renewable twice, up to three years, which is subject to mutual agreement between the employee and the university.)
10. Employment Conditions, Salary and Benefits:
 - 1) 38 hours and 45 minutes workweek (flexible-time system)
 - 2) Salary: approximately 4,600,000 yen per year (before tax withdrawal)
 - 3) Moving expenses, up to 300,000 yen, will be paid when employed.
The amount will be decided on after arrival, with the submission of necessary documents.
 - 4) Housing: Upon request, a modern university apartment will be provided at about 30,000 yen per month (4LDK: Four rooms with a kitchen and a bathroom).
 - 5) Research allowance: Approximately 200,000 yen per year
 - 6) A private office in the university building with a PC connected to the Internet and a laser printer

 - 1) Curriculum vitae with a 45mm x 50mm photograph attached

- 2) A copy of the diploma or graduation certificate of the last degree
 - 3) A list of academic publications
 - 4) Two major academic publications/achievements (off-prints or photocopies) and their abstracts
 - 5) A letter of recommendation (written either in English or in Japanese)
 - 6) A recorded description of your self-introduction and teaching methods (or your teaching philosophy) on a CD, a cassette tape, or something similar, for about five minutes in duration
