Associate Professor (sennin junkyoju) or Lecturer (sennin koshi), full-time (tenured)

The School of Information and Communication invites applications for a tenured teaching position as follows.

1. Position

A full-time, tenured position of Associate Professor or Lecturer of English Communication

2. Duties

Successful candidates will be expected to teach classes such as English Communication, English Phonetics, English Culture and History and other related classes, conduct research in their area, and perform a variety of educational, academic, and administrative duties at our School, Graduate School and other organs at our university.

3. Qualifications

- a. A doctoral degree in English education, English language or a related discipline, or an equivalent academic qualification
- b. Experience in teaching English language at the university or junior college level.
- c. L1 speaker of English or a similar level of proficiency in English.
- d. Advanced level of Japanese language proficiency to be able to perform all the administrative and educational duties

- e. Passion and commitment to English education and capacity to teach English language classes (speaking, listening, reading and writing) and academic English (presentation, writing).
- f. Academic achievements: 8 or more academic articles or books including at least two refereed publications for the Associate Professor level; 3 or more academic articles or books including at least 1 refereed publication for the Lecturer level

4. Start of employment

April 1, 2018

5. Selection process

Candidates who pass the initial document screening (mid-July) will be invited for the final screening tentatively scheduled on August 9. This will involve a trial class and an academic presentation by the candidate, followed by an interview. Candidates are required to provide a copy of their diplomas. Travel expenses will be reimbursed up to 200,000 JPY.
