Description	<p>(1) Subject: Topics in English (Japan) (Spring semester)</p> <p>Course description: Students continue to work to acquire the language and to develop the skills and strategies that will enable them to succeed in their academic and daily life in Tokyo and in Boston especially through the topics related to Japan.</p> <p>Teaching Day: Tuesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> periods</p> <p>(2) Subject: Society Today II (Fall semester)</p> <p>Course description: This class continues with the process begun in Society Today I, but increases the difficulty of the content. After a diagnostic by the teacher, specific authentic English texts and videos with accompanying activities in writing and vocabulary are selected for self-study outside the classroom. These activities support in-class comprehension and discussion activities that build on the topics. Students then prepare written work and oral presentations of these topics.
