JACET 60th Anniversary Events

Since its establishment in 1962, JACET has played a leading role in English education not only in Japan but also overseas.

Initially, the JACET 60th Anniversary Commemoration Week (Hiroshima, 2021) was to be hosted at Yasuda Women's University by the Chugoku-Shikoku Chapter. However, due to the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19), we decided to conduct the event entirely online to avoid concerns about postponement or cancellations. The theme of the Anniversary Commemoration Week (Online, 2021) is "Reflection and Reconnection." Looking back

on the 60 years since JACET was founded, we will envision the future and plan to accelerate interdisciplinary research across generations and borders as well as physical and virtual space. On the third day, the 60th Commemorative International Convention (Online, 2021) will be held under the theme of "English Language Education to Endure Changing Times: Facing the Reality of Society 5.0." In the morning, please join us for the first JACET Hours events. There will be a number of symposia and workshops proposed by JACET members, supporting members, SIGs, and chapters,

creating a festive atmosphere. In the afternoon, join us for the opening ceremony of the 60th Commemorative International Convention and plenary lectures, including a speech by the new JACET president.

In the morning of the fourth and fifth days, we will mainly focus on general research presentations. In order to make this event a truly international one, we decided to invite a wide range of participants from overseas in cooperation with overseas affiliated academic associations and AILA. Because the event is held online, there is no need to worry about the number of classrooms, so not only members but also non-members are invited to offer proposals
