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The Department of Foreign Languages is recruiting a faculty member as described below.

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1. Position: Lecturer / Assistant Professor
2. Fields of Specialization: English linguistics / English education / Anglophone literature
3. Teaching Responsibilities: [undergraduate] writing, English communication, primary English education, liberal arts etc.
4. Qualifications: The applicant should
  - (1) have a Ph.D. or equivalent qualification (although applicants holding a Master's degree or equivalent qualification will also be considered) or have a Ph. D. or a Master's degree, or equivalent, or superior knowledge and experience in their area of expertise.
  - (2) be a native speaker of English or have an equivalent proficiency in English.
  - (3) have a proficiency in Japanese sufficient to perform their duties if the applicant is not a native speaker of Japanese.
5. Educational / Research activities: Applicants are required, in principle, to hold a Ph.D. by the scheduled hiring date or to have at least three years of educational and research experience in the relevant field after obtaining a Master's degree.

7. Scheduled start of employment: April 1, 2025
