Foreign Language Education Center - English Education Division (FLEC-EED) at Nanzan University is seeking full-time contract-based English Language Instructors (L.I.s).

Job Type and Number of Positions: Two full-time contract-based English Language Instructors (L.I.s)

Job Description:

1. Teach a minimum of ten 100-minute classes per week.
2. Assist the Senior Language Instructors at FLEC-EED in a variety of ways including the development of teaching materials related to FLEC-EED.
3. Commit to the duties related to the management of the World Plaza operated by FLEC.
4. Attend internal meetings and Faculty Development (FD) sessions related to FLEC.
5. Conduct entrance examination duties.
6. Fulfil other duties related to the operation of FLEC.
7. Teach a five-day summer or winter intensive class (“English Immersion”).

Contract:

A full-time two-year contract, renewable once for 2 years, then renewable once for 1 year (maximum of 5 years) based on mutual consent.

Conditions:

1. Starting annual salary of approximately 5,300,000 yen.
2. Health insurance and other benefits are provided.

Location: Nanzan University, 18 Yamazato-cho, Showa-ku, Nagoya, Aichi 466-8673, JAPAN

Qualifications:

1. The applicant should be a native or near-native English speaker of any nationality.
2. The applicant should have a Master’s degree in English education or a similar internationally recognized qualification (e.g. Cambridge/RSA, DELTA).
3. The applicant should have at least two years of experience in teaching English, preferably at the university level.
4. Academic publications are desirable but not necessary.
5. If employed, the applicant should live in or near Nagoya City.

* Notes: Applicants are NOT eligible for this position if they were employed part-time or full-time under a limited term contract at Nanzan School Corporation during the six months prior to the beginning of the employment.

Deadline for applications: Application documents must reach the university by August 31, 2021.

Starting date: April 1, 2022

1. Curriculum vitae with a photo, contact information (phone number and e-mail address), education background, employment history, academic association memberships, and degrees conferred.
2. Professional achievements (e.g. contributions to professional associations, materials development, presentations, etc.), and a list of research publications (if any).

4. A 450-word essay written in English on the applicant’s approach to English language education and how this is reflected in classroom teaching.
5. A photocopy of diplomas or certificates.
6. Two letters of reference (sealed and which specify the relationship between the applicant and those who

provide references).

- Interviews may be conducted online rather than in person depending on the present situation concerning COVID-19.
