In the English Education Section of the Center for Language Education at the Institute for Promotion of Education & Campus Life (IPEC), each of our faculty members is sharing opinions for implementing a better English education program through the entire period of the bachelor's program to play a part in this endeavor. We are looking for motivated individuals, within and outside of IPEC, who will work together to promote English education reform at our university. Additionally, Okayama University strives to publish all official documents in both English and Japanese for internal and external use. We eagerly seek individuals who can be responsible for the dissemination of official documents in both languages. We would like to invite qualified individuals to apply for this position.

4. Duties will include:

- (1) Teaching general education English classes (20 koma per year [1 koma = 50 minutes x 16 times, including exam week]); in addition, may teach some graduate school courses
 - * One academic year consists of four terms with 50-minute periods (excluding night classes).
- (2) Participating in professional development programs and materials development for general English education
- (3) Helping to plan, evaluate, and improve the university-wide English education curriculum and programs
- (4) Contributing to IPEC management and administration along with extra-curricular support
- (5) Contributing to university-wide duties, including entrance examination work
- (6) Other duties, such as translation of documents, if requested by the Institute Director

5. Qualifications:

- (1) A doctoral degree or equivalent in English Education (such as TEFL/TESL), Applied Linguistics, Second Language Acquisition, English Linguistics, or have conducted research in a related field
- (2) Sufficient ability to communicate and write in both Japanese and English; any nationality is welcome to apply
- (3) The ability to take initiative on projects or tasks; a positive attitude to work in cooperation with others to address various university-related issues
- (4) Extensive teaching and research experience at an institution of higher education
- (5) It is highly recommended that the candidate live in Okayama city or in the surrounding area if hired.
- 6. Starting date: April 1, 2024
- 7. Term of employment: Permanent position. The retirement age is 65.
- 8. Employment details (in accordance with the Employment Regulations of Okayama University): The employed individual will be paid on an annual salary basis. The specific amount is in accordance with the salary regulations of the National University Corporation Okayama University and is based on the individual's work experience, credentials, education, and qualifications.
