① Communicative English: Tuesdays 10:55 AM - 12:25 PM

A required class for first-year university students focusing on speaking and listening skills, with a class size of 25-30

② English Writing/Presentations: Thursdays 10:55 - 12:25 PM

An elective class mainly for first-year university students in which students learn to write English paragraphs and/or essays (spring semester), and give English presentations (fall semester), with a class size of 10-20 students

It is possible to teach ① only, or both ① and ② (teaching only ② is not possible).

Please specify in your application whether you are available to teach only the Tuesday Communicative English class, or both the Tuesday and Thursday classes. Starting in the 2025 academic year, there may be a chance to teach additional classes as well.
