

### Faculty Position in the Center for Multilingual Education, Osaka University

Outline	Osaka University seeks applications from qualified candidates for one full-time position for teaching English as a Foreign Language to undergraduates, commencing on April 1, 2022. A successful applicant will be affiliated with the English Education Group, Center for Multilingual Education. Details of the position are given below.

4. Work Location	Toyonaka Campus  (1-8 Machikaneyama-cho, Toyonaka-City, Osaka, Japan)
5. Specialized Field	English Language Education or a related field such as linguistics or literature
6. Responsibilities	(1) Number of classes to be taught: Nine classes (90-minute) per week (in principle) (2) Collaborative research and other professional service
7. Qualifications	[Essential] Applicants must have: (1) Native fluency in English (2) A Master's or higher degree in English language education or a related field such as linguistics or literature (3) At least two years' teaching experience (4) At least two publications

9. Term of Employment	From the starting date to March 31st, 2025 *Following completion of the term, the contract may be extended subject to evaluation (the extension limit is 10 years from the starting date).
